



Chito-Ryu Karate Kennebecasis Valley Karate Club 2009 – 2010 Fee Structure

KV Karate Club has two semesters per year. Classes are held twice a week on Wednesdays and Sundays in Rothesay. Additionally, karate members can attend classes in Hampton on Mondays and Thursdays free of charge with paid membership to KV Karate. Please note that the classes are held in the gymnasium of Rothesay High School and Hampton Elementary. Days may need to be adjusted because of school activities.

Semester 1: September 9, 2009 – January 31, 2010

Semester 2: February 1, 2010 – June 16, 2010

KVK-Rothesay meets: Sundays at 2:00pm, Wednesdays at 7:00pm (Rothesay High School Gym)
KVK-Hampton meets: Mondays at 6:30pm, Thursdays at 6:30pm (Hampton Elementary Gym)

CLUB DUES:

Cost per 1 member	\$150 per semester.
Cost per 2 or more children	\$300 per semester.
Parent of participating children	\$50 per semester.

Dues are collected at the beginning of each semester. Members may pay for the full year. Receipts will be provided.

Our club encourages family participation. It is much better to be active with your children than waiting in the bleachers! The reduced fee is to cover dues outside of our own club.

Part of the registration fee that KV Karate collects goes toward annual fees on behalf of the following associations: Canadian and Provincial Chito Ryu Associations, Karate New Brunswick and National Karate Association.

In the beginning, students may wear a tee shirt (white preferably) and sweatpants (no shorts please). Students participate barefoot. Most students who stay in karate will opt to purchase a “gi” (traditional Japanese training uniform). The club orders gi’s during the semester if you are interested.

Students are presented with a belt and certificate at each belt level as they progress to brown belt. The fee for successful belt grading is \$30.

Karate Participant's Indemnity and Release

- Karate can be physically and mentally challenging.
- Karate is practiced without protective clothing and equipment.
